Despite the unspeakable tragedy we all experienced upon the death of Pastor Hopeton, going ahead with the trip was seen as a tribute to his memory. We would like to share our memories with you.

Today, after the 11 a.m. service, there will be a forum to report on the trip and share what we learned, particularly examining the response of the church to slavery and to the education of enslaved people. The program will be held in the Christian Education building, lower level. The History Committee will provide lunch for those in attendance.
