## Worship and Program Highlights-Sunday, May 25, 2025

## The Rev. Dr. Frank Crouch - Guest Preacher & Lectures

When it comes to race and racism, Moravians have our own stories of villains and heroes, complacency and prophecy, complicity and resistance. Moravian archival records, both North and South, reveal a long-term insider view of the actions and decisions of church leaders, congregations, agencies, and Synods. Some of these have lain dormant, without public discussion, for decades or centuries. We'll explore some of the lowlights and highlights of what Moravians have done—for worse and for better—with respect to slavery, segregation, and discrimination. These sometimes sobering, sometimes inspiring stories offer both a lens and a mirror, as we look at "them" then and ourselves now. The Rev. Dr. Frank Crouch will be our guest preacher on June 1st and will present his two-part lecture series on Wednesday, June 4 and Wednesday, June 11 at 7 p.m. in the Christian Education building, lower level. ## Confirmation Meeting: June 1

Confirmation is a rite by which persons baptized as children publicly affirm the covenant made for them in baptism and join the church as an adult member, and a time that our congregation affirms this important step of their faith journey. Meetings will include both a time to learn more about the Bible, their faith journey and Moravian living heritage, as well as field trips to visit other faiths and explore the ways Central serves the greater community. Maybe now more than ever, it is vital for our young people to know that they are loved by God and a community outside of their immediate family, and we encourage all youth ages 12-16 who haven't been confirmed to consider joining next year's class. An important planning meeting will occur next Sunday, June 1 at 11:15 a.m. (right after the 10 a.m. worship service) in the Kleiner Saal (2<sup>nd</sup> floor) of the Sanctuary for parents and youth to review a potential calendar, establish best meeting times, and answer any questions.
